O'Keeffe Landscape Tour Tour the landscape of Ghost Ranch by motorbus and see through your own eyes the scenes and actual locations of Georgia O'Keeffe's paintings interwoven with stories of her fifty years at Ghost Ranch. Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday 1:30 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. | \$29

Walk in Georgia O'Keeffe's Footsteps A walking tour down a private road takes you through what O'Keeffe called "her red hills," the Chinle formation. Learn about the history, geology, flora and fauna, culture of the area. 1.5 miles Friday 9:00 - 11:30 a.m. | \$45

O'Keeffe Trail Tour by Horseback Ride out to the area where Georgia O'Keeffe found her inspiration.

Ruth Hall Museum of Paleontology

Home of the New Mexico State Fossil! Watch as bones of small dinosaurs are discovered right before your eyes! Ghost Ranch is known worldwide among paleontologists as the home of Coelophysis (SEE-Low-FY-sis), the little dinosaur found at Ghost Ranch in 1947. Exhibits highlight the Triassic animals from 210 million years ago.

Florence Hawley Ellis Museum of Anthropology

See artifacts from the prehistoric Tewa, Gallina and other cultures which inhabited this ancient cultural highway created by the Chama River. Also featuring contemporary displays of santos and religious carving in the Spanish Colonial tradition and changing exhibits of local textile and folk art.
