





C.C. CRAGIN (BLUE RIDGE) LAKE

General Information

Located about 52 miles southwest of Winslow AZ or 69 miles southeast of Flagstaff, this narrow, winding body of water looks more like a canyon-bound river than a lake. Providing the water source for Payson, AZ, this lake is nestled between forested canyon walls and provides picturesque water recreation in a secluded, wooded setting.

Activities

Fishing, boating (less than 10 hp), camping, hiking, wild-life viewing, and photography.

Facilities

Developed campground at Rock Crossing Campground located 4 miles from the lake on FR 751. Thirty-two (32) single unit campsites and with tables, fire rings, and cooking grills. Drinking water at the campgrounds, toilets (self-composting), and hiking trails nearby. Campground is open Memorial Day to mid-fall, closed during winter months.

Fees

Campsites fees required when open.

Fishing license is required from the Arizona Game and Fish.

Arizona Game and Fish Department stocks this lake with rainbow, brown and brook trout.
