

# Two Rivers Marina at Navajo State Park



The Two Rivers Marina is located where the Piedra and San Juan rivers meet. We are a high desert area with an altitude of 6,100 feet and have 150 miles of shoreline. The full service marina offers the following features and services.

## Features:

- **Marina** - fuel, ice, tackle, accessories, cold drinks and a clean restroom
- **Slips** - daily, monthly and yearly with power and water to most.
- **Mooring** - 75 mooring balls with shuttle service to most.
- **Dry Storage** - over 3.5 acres of fenced and locked area for your boat or RV.
- **Pump Out Station** - available for houseboats or day cruiser.
- **Camping** - over 120 campsites, showers and vending machines. Cabins also available.

## Services:

- Launch & retrieve from dry storage.
- Battery boost or charge.
- Emergency fuel or battery boost on water.

Slips \$7.50 per foot plus electricity, \$175.00 monthly minimum

- **Mooring Ball**

\$4.00 per foot, monthly minimum \$125.00

- **Dry Storage**

\$1.50 per foot, monthly \$25.00 minimum


