



## San Juan County Disc Golf Courses

### Aztec

(Map #4)

Located east of Tiger Lake, this is the newest Disc Golf Course in San Juan County. It has recently been laid out for 18 holes and will have tee boxes and baskets installed by this summer. The course layout is designed for the Pro with long PAR 5 distances in mind. The public is invited to test out this course as it is being developed. The course will be open year round and is free. The terrain is sloped with a major ridge system in the middle of the course which provides for some great overviews and throwing distances.

### Berg Park

(Map #3)

Located across the Animas River from Berg Park East, this 10-hole disc golf course is an informal course with simple PVC pipe targets and approximate tee markings with pin flags. This course is normally played as part of the Four Corners Disc Golf League, but all are welcome to play on it from dawn until dusk as it is part of the Farmington River trails system. The terrain is relatively flat with numerous cottonwood obstacles which makes the course more technical.

### Lions Wilderness

(Map #1)

This unique disc golf course sits within the high desert terrain of Farmington's Lions Wilderness Park. The 27-hole course is more than a mile long, open year round, entrance into the course is free, and the hours are from dawn to dusk year-round. Foliage on the course is a mix of juniper and pinon providing a beautifully landscaped course with foliage obstacles that remain the same year-round.

### Majestic Enchantment


(Map #5)

Located at the private facility in the community of Turley, this 18-hole disc golf course is one of the most challenging courses in Northwest New Mexico. The course is situated adjacent to the San Juan River among large cottonwood trees to provide one with plenty of shade during the summer. Next door is the Wines of the San Juan where one can enjoy a drink after a day of disc golfing.

### San Juan College

(Map #2)

Located on the campus of San Juan College, this disc golf course is a local favorite! This 27-hole course was installed by the Youth Conservation Corps of New Mexico which covers over 2 miles and borders the City of Farmington's lush and legendary desert Pinon Hills Golf Course in the high desert terrain of Northern New Mexico.
