Walleye, northern pike, channel catfish, smallmouth bass, brown trout, and white sucker.

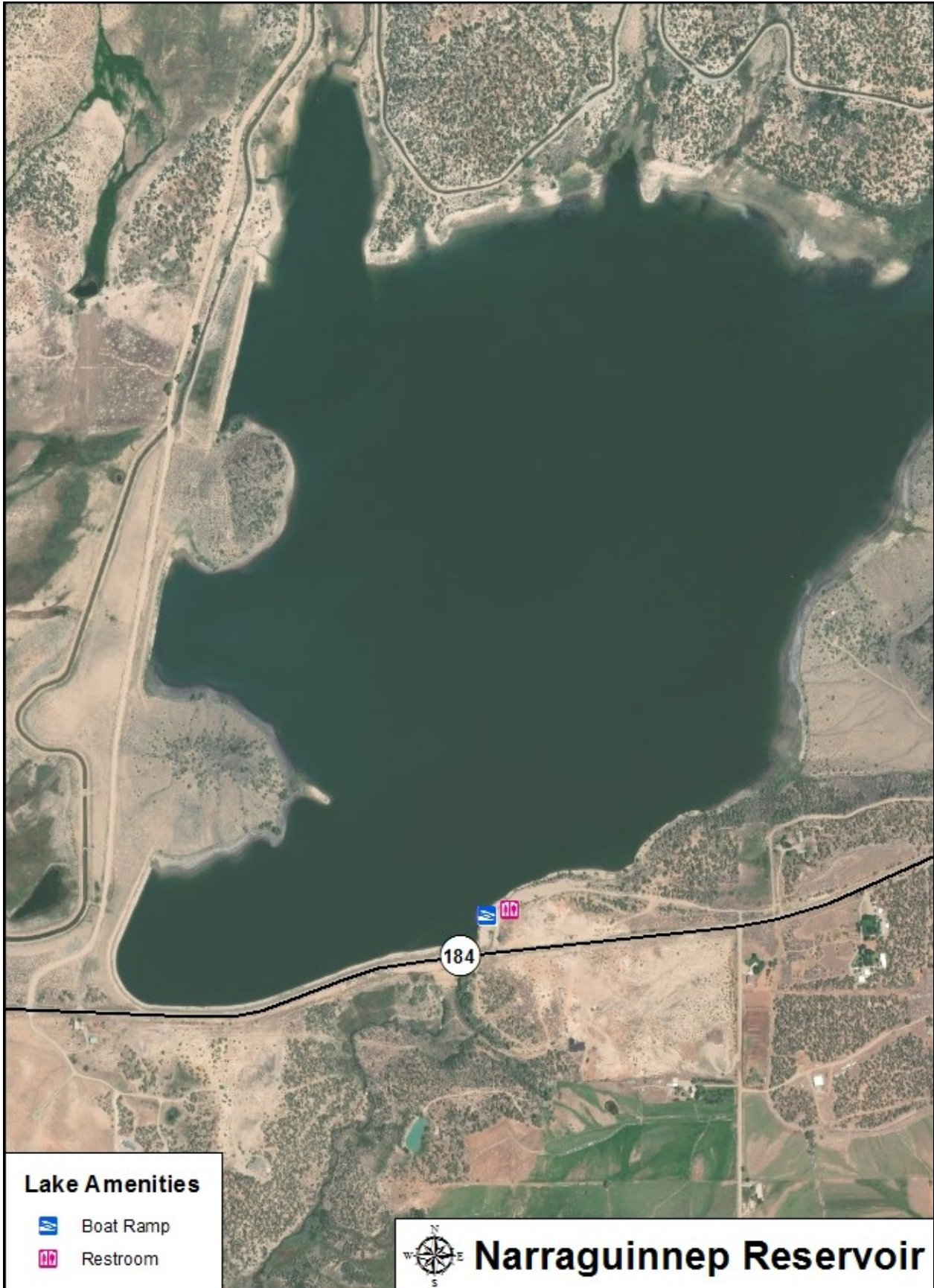
**There is a fishing advisory for this water body due to mercury levels.**
